Resolution #CC23-01-24-001 -Gault Institute

Whereas Policy FCB "Major School Change" was enacted on January 11, 2022; and whereas meetings of the Council of the Whole have taken place over the course of the past year; and whereas these meetings have provided commissioners an opportunity to explore different scenarios, have important discussions, and launch two public consultations; and whereas the public has provided important feedback which has been taken into consideration;

Therefore, it was moved by Commissioner P. Stuckey, seconded by Commissioner L. Chouinard, that the New Frontiers School Board authorize the Director General to request of the Ministry of Education authorization and funding to build a new elementary school to alleviate the overcrowding situation in the Chateauguay elementary schools.
