

POLICY	SERVING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT SCHOOL OR STAFF FUNCTIONS (BM)

1. PURPOSE & SCOPE

- 1.1 Policy BM relates to the serving of alcohol at staff or school functions on New Frontiers School Board (NFSB) premises. The serving of alcoholic beverages on NFSB premises on any other occasion must conform to the regulations outlined in NFSB's Policy FK "Community Use of School Board Facilities".
- 1.2 The school principal or centre director may authorize, following consultation with the Director General, the serving of alcohol at staff functions or at functions involving members of the school and parental groups under the following conditions:
 - No elementary school students be in the school when alcoholic beverages are being consumed.
 - No secondary or adult students be within the section of the school or centre where alcoholic beverages are being consumed.
 - No alcohol be served after 11:00 pm.
- 1.3 The Director General may authorize the serving of alcoholic beverages at an event organized by a school or centre as a fundraising activity, a school graduation ceremony, etc. under the terms and conditions they determine to be appropriate. If such activities involve the selling of alcoholic beverages, a license must be obtained from the Quebec "*Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux*".
- 1.4 In each case referred to above, the school principal, centre principal, or director in charge is responsible for participating in the planning and execution of such functions and will be accountable to the Director General.

2. AUTHORITY

- 2.1 This Policy is administered by the Director General.

3. REVIEW

- 3.1 The Director General will review this Policy at least once every five (5) years.
